



New Features

- NEW! Users can now process their Scanned Applications when Reviewing Incoming Applications!
 - The Process Scanned Applications button has been added to the Review Incoming Applications page.
 - If the system detects a perfect match, an application will be created.
 - If the system detects a potential duplicate, the application will be added to Review Incoming Applications.
 - The source of the application will be listed as Scanned.



- NEW! Administrators on a "Master/Parent" Meals Plus database will now be able to share their Menus data to selected "Child" (District/School) databases.
 - The grid will display the District ID, District Description and the Date the Menu
 was last shared. If the menu has not been shared yet, the Last Shared On field
 will be blank.




The Share option has been added to the Menus Cog Options.

The Share option is only available on "Parent/Master" districts.



- The descriptions for ingredients, recipe and menus can be **Duplicated** for districts that utilize menu sharing.
- Ingredients, recipes and menus that have been **Shared** with a "**Child**" district will now display the source as the "**Master/Parent**" district that the items originated from.
- "Child" districts that receive ingredients, recipes and menus from their "Master/Parent" district will not be able to make changes to the shared items.
- **Shared** items will be tagged as **Read-Only** on the "**Child**" district database to maintain consistency and quality control across databases.
- Ingredients, recipes and menus that been Shared with a "Child" district database will now automatically update when the "Master/Parent" district information on their database has been edited.
- "Child" districts will receive a notification that information has been updated by their "Master/Parent" district upon logging in.
- "Child" districts now receive a notification that they have received Menus data from their "Master/Parent" district upon logging in.

Close School Year

- The error causing users to be unable to close the school year due to the "FTPHostName on type 'PSConfiguration' not found" error has been corrected.
- The error causing users to be unable to close the school year due to the "Please try again. The INSERT statement conflicted with the FOREIGN KEY constraint "FK_StudentHistory_Household". The conflict occurred in database "MPDB_EastClinto", table "dbo.Household", column 'Id'. The statement has been terminated" error has been corrected.
- The error causing users to unnecessarily receive an error message requiring them to import their income brackets for the following year when attempting to close the school year has been corrected.
